What is different about these two signs?



Romans 5:8-10 (ESV)

(8) ...God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (9) Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God. (10) For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

Galatians 2:20 (ESV)

The Key to living as a Christian is an **MERGED** Life.



The **PERSONS** of a Merged Life.

- One Person is dead – **ME**.
- Only One Person is alive – **CHRIST JESUS**.



The PROMISE of a Merged Life. *Colossians 3:3-11*



The PRESCRIPTION for a Merged Life.

- A. KNOW – Understand who Christ is and who you are in Him.
- B. ABIDE – Rest in the truth of who Christ is and who you are in Him. He is your life. *John 15:4-5*
- C. COUNT – Live based upon the EXACT truth as applied to your life. *Romans 6:8-11*
